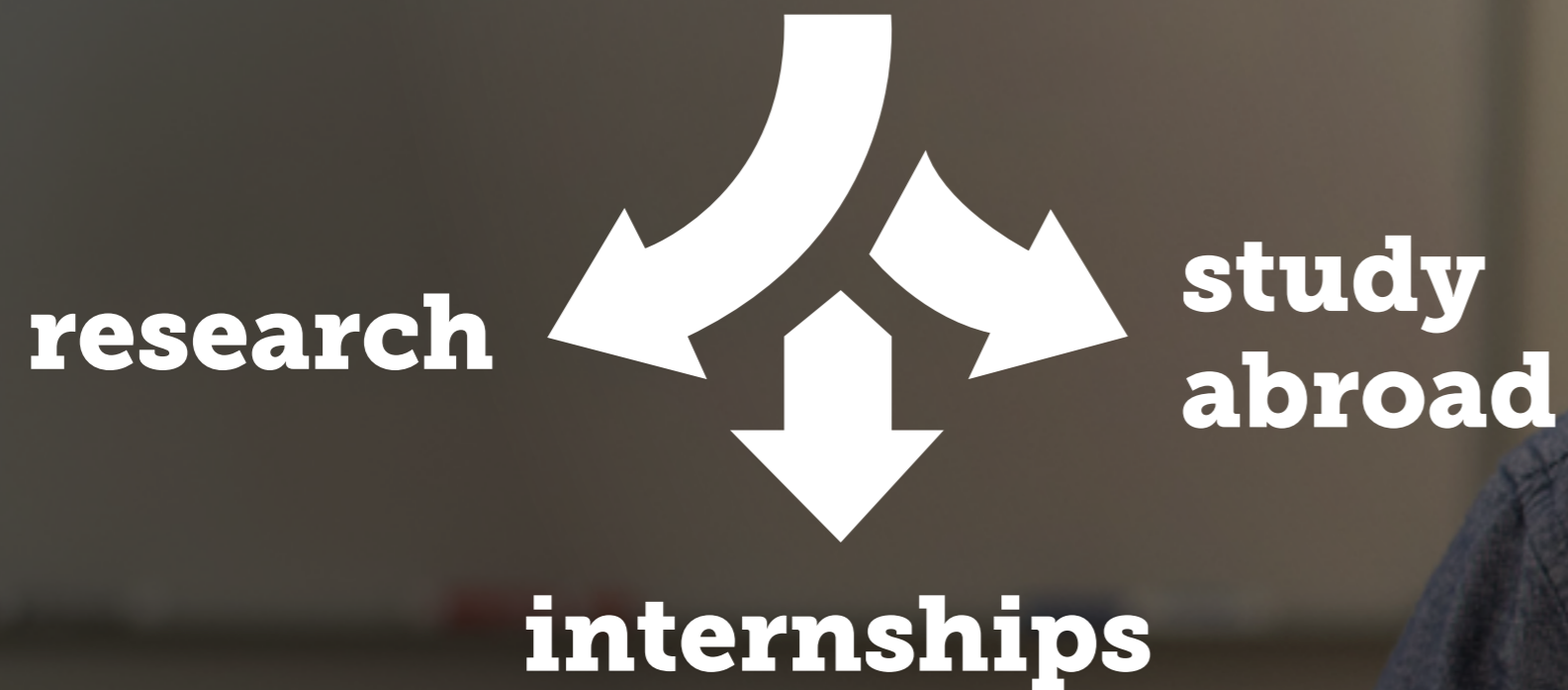

Campus housing requirements

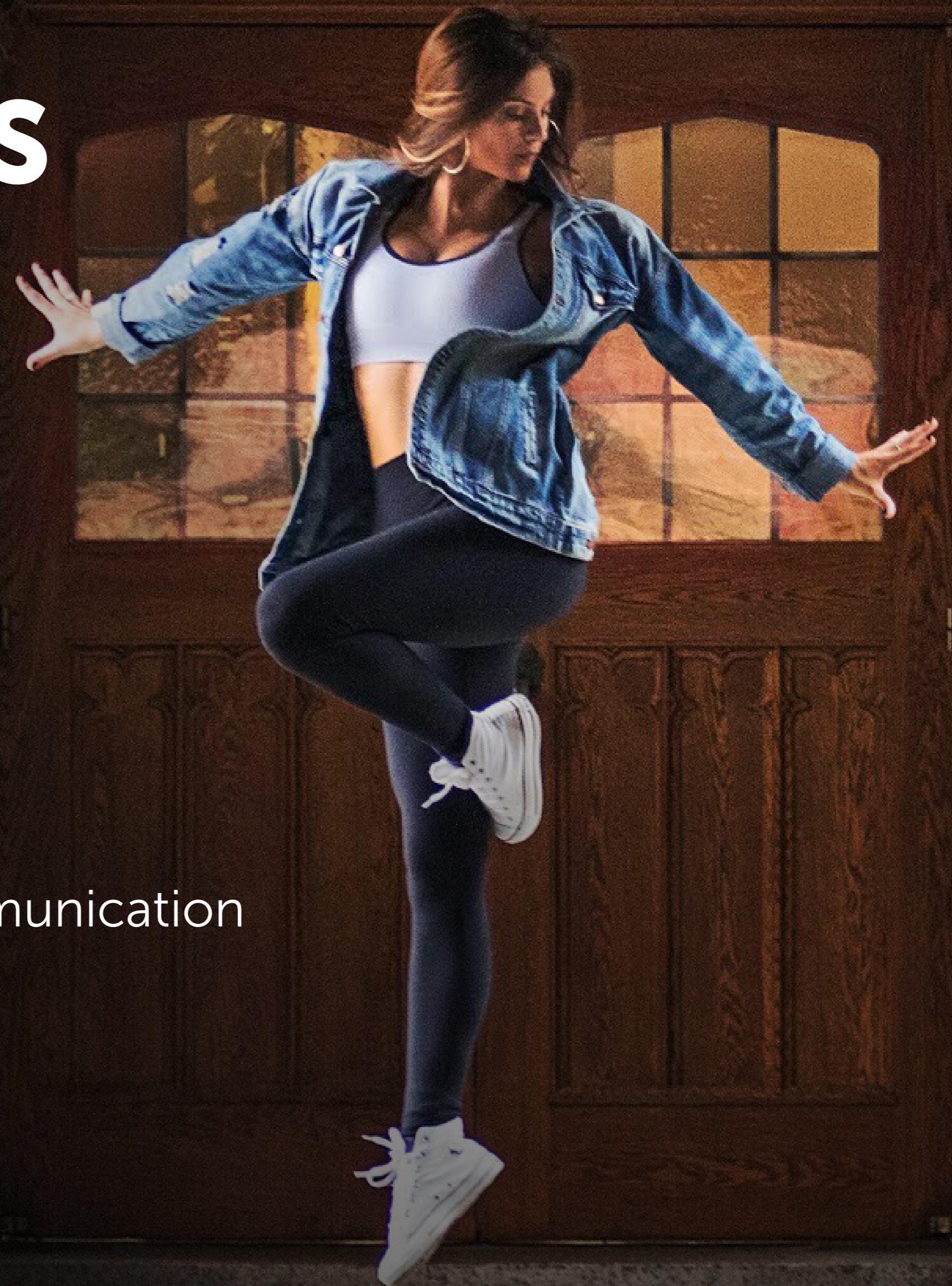


Transportation (cars on campus, tunnels, etc.)



APP REQUIREMENTS

- Common Application
- Official high school and college transcripts
- SAT or ACT are optional
(required for LECOM and 3+3 law programs)
- Personal Statement
- Letters of Recommendation (min 1/max 3)
- Portfolio review required for art, visual communication design, and technical production majors.
- Auditions required for performance majors

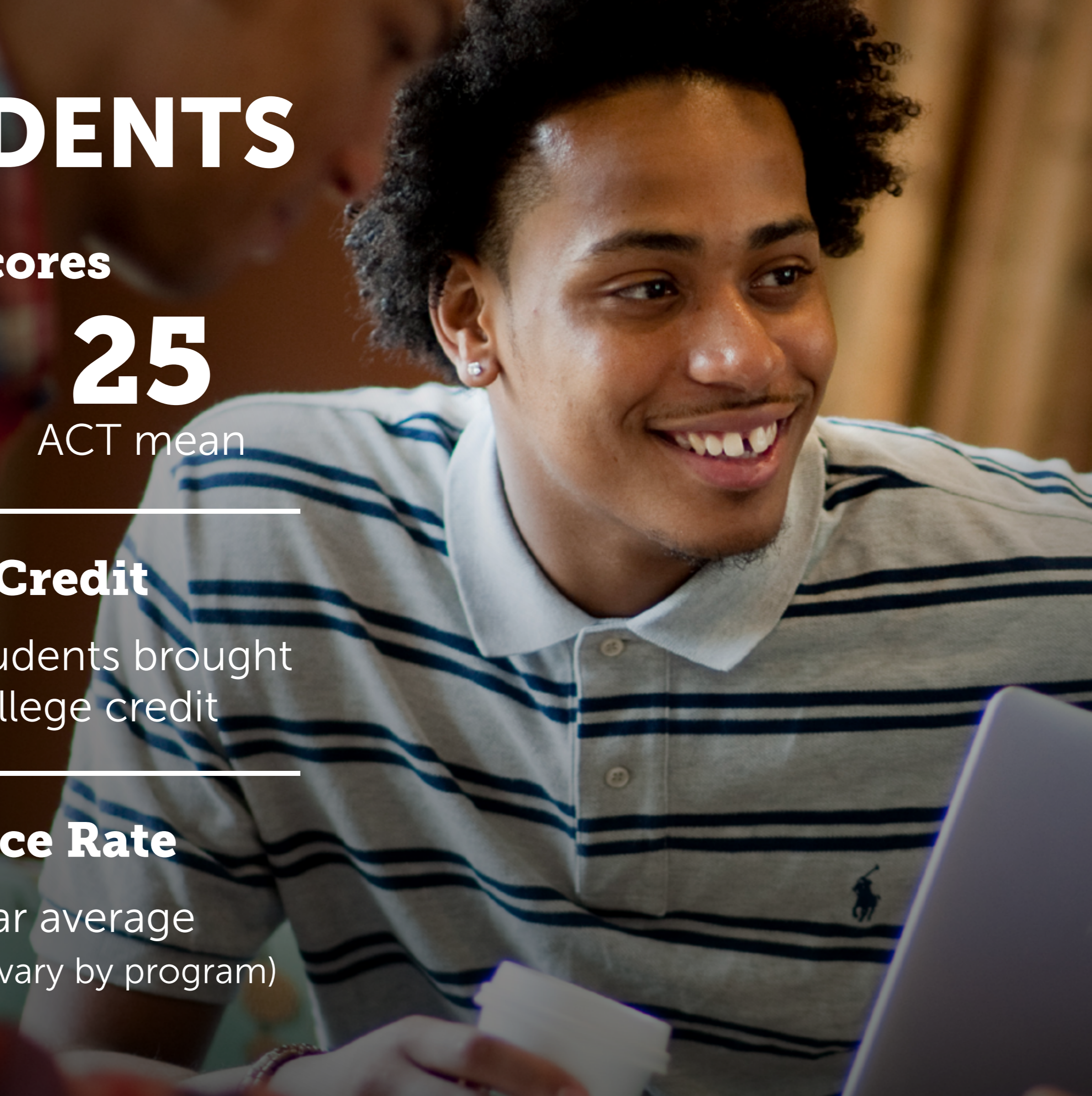


