## Special Programs

**Honors Program:** Five honors courses and a senior independent study are required to complete Wagner's honors program. Freshmen may live in an honors-themed community in a residence hall.

**Civic Engagement:** Bonner Leaders is a four-year program, with scholarship support, in which students meet regularly and take on increasing levels of responsibility with community organizations. The IMPACT Scholars Network provides enrichment and support for students' civic engagement work. MOVE: Beyond the Bench helps student-athletes to enhance their academic learning and civic engagement.

**Study Abroad:** Wagner offers short-term study abroad courses through the Expanding Your Horizons Program, as well as semester, summer, or year abroad opportunities at locations throughout the world.
