Program Options

Associate Degree Options

- **Weekday** – completed in 2yrs, classes held Mon-Fri
- **Evening/Weekend** – 18 month accelerated option, classes held every Wed and every other Fri, Sat & Sun.

Bachelor Degree Options

- **Dual Degree Partnership in Nursing (DDPN)** – in conjunction with Le Moyne College, 1+2+1 format
- **Accelerated Dual Degree Partnership in Nursing (A-DDPN)** – in conjunction with Le Moyne College, for those with a bachelor's degree in a major other than nursing, 18 month accelerated option



Admission Requirements

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Completion of algebra, biology, and chemistry at the high school or college level – should be regents level if attended high school in NYS
- GPA of 3.0 or higher in coursework to be considered for transfer credit
- High School GPA of 85 or higher for **current high school students only**



General Education Courses

- **Critical Writing** – this is usually the freshman writing course taken in college
- **Intro to Psychology**
- **Intro to Sociology**
- **Human Life Span Development** – also known as Developmental Psychology. Child Psychology or Adolescent Psychology also accepted
- **Human Anatomy & Physiology I&II with lab**
- **Basic Microbiology with lab**

Start Date – August 2021

Evening/Weekend – Application Deadline – **Sept 1, 2021**

Start Date – July 2022

Bachelor Degree options:

DDPN – Application Deadline **Nov 15, 2020 early action** or

Feb 1, 2021 regular decision

Start Date – August 2021

A-DDPN - Application Deadline – **Nov 1, 2020**

Start Date – July 2021

**Apply online through Le Moyne College –
select A-DDPN as your major*
