# Why are we here?

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All Title I schools are required to hold an annual meeting for Title I parents for the purpose of informing you of:

- Our school's participation in the Title I Program
- The requirements of Title I, Part A
- How parents and families can be informed and involved (Parent's Right to Know)

# What does it mean to be a Title I School?

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Being a Title I school means receiving federal funding to supplement the school's existing programs. The funds are used to:

- identify students experiencing academic difficulties and providing timely assistance to help students' meet NYS standards
- purchase supplementary materials and supplies
- conduct parent involvement and engagement meetings
- recruit/hire/retain highly qualified teachers

Being a Title I school also means encouraging parental involvement and advocating for parents' rights.

# What is the Parent and Family Engagement Policy

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This policy addresses how the school will implement the parental involvement requirements of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act*. It includes...

- The school's expectations for parents
- How the school will involve parents in decision making
- How the school will work to build the schools' and parents' capacity for strong parental involvement to improve student academic achievement

Title I parents have the right to be involved in the development of the school's Parent and Family Engagement Policy.

# What is the School-Parent Compact?

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The compact is a commitment from the school, the parent, and the student, to share in the responsibility for improved academic achievement.
