

## Network Account Authorization and Technology User Agreement

Completion of the log-in process on any computer in the Oneida City School District signifies your agreement to abide by the policies and procedures of the Oneida City School District regarding the appropriate use of technology resources made available to you by the district.

The Oneida City School District recognizes that the use of electronic technology and networks must be consistent with the purpose, goals and mission of the district. It is imperative that staff, students, and guests conduct themselves in a responsible, decent, ethical and polite manner while using such equipment and networks.

Any use of District equipment or Information networks for inappropriate, illegal, obscene or sexual harassment purposes is prohibited. Illegal activities shall be defined as a violation of local, state, and/or federal laws as well as the district's policies, rules and regulations. Inappropriate use shall be defined as a violation of the intended purpose of the network. Obscene activities shall be defined as a violation of generally accepted social standards for use of a publicly-owned and operated communication vehicle.

Any use of district's equipment or network information for commercial purposes; for individual profit or gain; for private business advertisement or political lobbying; or that which may disrupt use by other users or invade the privacy of individuals is strictly prohibited.

In signing, I acknowledge that I have read the District's INTERNET SAFETY POLICY (No. 5300) and PURPOSE, USE AND ADMINISTRATION OF DISTRICT DIGITAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS (No. 5301), and I am required to abide by this and other policies and procedures of the Oneida City School District as related to the use of technology. 
